Engaging God on the heavenly pathways of relation and responsibility

Glossary

- Mandate: A specific authorisation to act e.g. John 5:19 Jesus only doing what He saw the Father doing
- Scroll: A heavenly book or record e.g. of a blueprint, mandate or our destiny e.g. Psalm 139:16
- Mountain: A position of authority in the heavenly realms and a representation of our spirit e.g. Isaiah 2:2
- Throne: A place of government where we are seated in the heavenly realms usually on a mountain
- Sceptre: A symbol of authority and rulership that we are invested with to use on our mountain thrones.
- Investiture: The ceremony where those in spiritual authority are given authority by Jesus on their mountain throne usually given a crown, sceptre and a mantle and sometimes a weapon or tool.
- Mantle: A cloak or garment of authority for rulership e.g. Elijah 2 Kings 2:13
- Court: A place in the heavenly realms where kingdom judgment and justice is administered. E.g. Zechariah 3:1-7
- Chancellor: A spiritual being who has a high level of authority to operate in the heavenly realms. (Court of Chancellors)
- Scribe: A spiritual being who is responsible for recording events in the heavenly realms. (Court of Scribes)
- Bench of 3, Beit Din, Apostolic Council: The pattern of heavenly government (Father, Son, Spirit) that should be reflected on earth so that God will fill that shadow with His authority, presence and glory.
- 7 mountains: The pattern of heavenly government (7 spirits of God) that represent spheres of government in the Kingdom of God realm of heaven to be outworked in our own lives.
- Arc: The agreement or connection between two points that causes a
 manifestation of God's presence, glory. e.g. between the wings of the
 cherubim on the mercy seat covering the ark in the earthly and heavenly holy
 of holies in the tabernacle.
- Tabernacle: The pattern of the whole heavenly realms, Outer court, Holy
 Place and Holy of Holies and a literal heavenly and earthly structure.
- 4 faces of God: Lion, Ox, Eagle, Man representing the government of the order of Melchizedek; King, Prophet, Apostle, Priest

- Veil: The barrier opened by Jesus between heavenly and earthly realms. The matrix or curtain between different heavenly realms e.g. outer courts and Holy place.
- Cloud of witnesses, Men in white linen, spirits of righteous men made perfect: The spirits of believers from both old and new covenant who those have died physically but who now live in the heavenly realms and who surround us.
- 7 spirits of God: Created spiritual beings empowered by God to train and tutor us into our mandated positions of authority within God's kingdom.
- Eden: God's heavenly garden that once again overlaps heaven and earth from which flows the river of life.
- Kingdom of God: God's rule and reign, a heavenly realm of light and darkness where resides our mountain thrones, where we rule as lords, mobile court of accusation, Court of angels and Court of War(strategy council)
- Kingdom of heaven: Heavenly realm where resides higher authority mountain thrones, Court of Chancellors, Court of Scribes and Wisdoms Heights
- Heaven: The heavenly realm where resides the Mountain of God (Mount Zion), the thrones of God, Tree of life
- Fires stones: The 9 stones on the Mountain of God where Lucifer walked (Ezekiel 28) that contain multi-level layers so revelation of the eternal purposes of mankind
- Waterfalls: Places in the heavenly realms where the river of life flows down the mountain of God. Where deep calls to deep and God releases revelation
- River of life: The source of life that flows from the throne of God through the
 Tree of Life and the various heavenly realms and is the pathway to eternity. It
 flow into our spirits through our first love gate when we drink living water
 and becomes a spring of eternal life that that flows as rivers deeper into our
 lives through the garden of our hearts
- First love gate: The gate in our spirit to the kingdom of God (God's dwelling and place of rulership within us) where we daily invite God to fill us and rule over us e.g. Luke 17:21, Revelation 3:20
- Engagement: An personal encounter with God within our spirits, hearts or in a heavenly realm
- Activation: An exercise that helps us engage God in a personal encounter within our spirits, hearts or in a heavenly realm.
