- Jesus died so we could inherit left us -
- Open door to a relationship with God
- Open access to the Father & therefore heaven
- Eternal spiritual life starting now
- Redemption & Reconciliation, Adoption, Relationship, Family - Sonship
- Destiny, Purpose & His Mantle of authority

# Inheritance 7

- 1 Cor 10:11 Now these things happened to them as **an example**, and they were **written for our instruction**, upon whom the ends of the ages have come.
- Journey from slavery to sonship
- Journey of restoration of inheritance
- Joshua Generation inherits & enables the next generation to inherit also

# Joshua Generation 5

21. Joshua generation will free the next generation from the reproach and effects of past generations into new revelation of past activities

- Joshua 5:8 Now when they had finished **circumcising** all the nation, they remained in their places in the camp until they **were healed**. 9 Then the LORD said to Joshua, “Today I have **rolled away the reproach of Egypt** from you.”.. 10 While the sons of Israel camped at Gilgal they observed the **Passover**..

# Joshua Generation 5

- Consecrating ourselves setting our lives apart for God's purposes – our inheritance
- Cross Jordan leaving our old identity as a slave & orphan behind
- Leave old ways of provision, protection of childhood behind
- Embracing the responsibility & authority of sonship



# Joshua Generation 5

- Rom 2:29 ... circumcision is that which is of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter ..
- Reproach – shame, disgrace, blame, disapproval, disappointment of our past lives removed
- Old identity of slave, orphan, victim, sinner, failure, useless, hopeless removed
- Sign of a covenant relationship where theirs hearts were set apart for God

# Joshua Generation 5

21. Joshua generation will free the next generation from the reproach and effects of past generations into new revelation of past activities

- Joshua 5:8 Now when they had finished **circumcising** all the nation, they remained in their places in the camp until they **were healed**. 9 Then the LORD said to Joshua, “Today I have **rolled away the reproach of Egypt** from you.”.. 10 While the sons of Israel camped at Gilgal they observed the **Passover**..

# Joshua Generation 5

- 1 Peter 1:18 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19 but with **precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.** 20 For He was foreknown **before the foundation of the world,** but has appeared in these last times for the sake of you
- Rev 13:8 ... the book of life of the **Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.**



# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 12:1 Now the Lord said to Abram, “Go forth from your country, And from your relatives And from your father’s house, **To the land which I will show you**; 2 And I will make you a great nation, And I will bless you, And make your name great; And so you shall be a blessing; 3 And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse. And **in you all the families of the earth will be blessed.**”



# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 15:9 God said to him, “Bring Me a three year old heifer, and a three year old female goat, and a three year old ram, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon.” 10 Then he brought all these to Him and cut them in two, and laid each half opposite the other; but he did not cut the birds.
- Gen 15:17 It came about when the sun had set, that it was very dark, and behold, there appeared a smoking oven and a flaming torch which **passed between these pieces.**

# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 15:13 God said to Abram, “Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where they will be **enslaved and oppressed** four hundred years. 14 But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with many possessions.

# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 15:18 On that day the **Lord made a covenant** with Abram, saying, “To your **descendants** I have given **this land**, From the river of Egypt as far as the great river, the river Euphrates: 19 the Kenite and the Kenizzite and the Kadmonite 20 and the Hittite and the Perizzite and the Rephaim 21 and the Amorite and the Canaanite and the Girgashite and the Jebusite.”

# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 22:8 Abraham said, “**God will provide for Himself the lamb** for the burnt offering, my son.” So the two of them walked on together.<sup>9</sup> Then they came to the place of which God had told him; and Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood, and bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. <sup>10</sup> Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son.



# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 22:11 But the angel of the Lord called to him from heaven and said, “Abraham, Abraham!” And he said, “Here I am.” 12 He said, “Do not stretch out your hand against the lad, and do nothing to him; for now I know that you fear God, since you have **not withheld your son, your only son, from Me**
- Law of precedent

# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 22:13 Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him a ram caught in the thicket by his horns; and Abraham went and **took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of his son.** 14 Abraham called the name of that place **The Lord Will Provide**, as it is said to this day, “In the **mount of the Lord** it will be provided.”

# Joshua Generation 5

- Gen 22:15 Then the angel of the Lord called to Abraham a second time from heaven, 16 and said, “By Myself I have sworn, declares the Lord, because you have done this thing and **have not withheld your son, your only son**, 17 indeed I will greatly bless you, and I **will greatly multiply your seed** as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies. 18 In **your seed** all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.”

# Joshua Generation 5

- Gal 3:6 Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, “And to seeds,” as referring to many, but rather to one, “And to **your seed,**” **that is, Christ.**
- Jesus - Seed Adam, Abraham, David
- Rom 4:13 For the promise to Abraham or to his descendants is that he would be **heir of the world**



# Joshua Generation 5

- Ex 11:5 and all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of the Pharaoh who sits on his throne, even to the firstborn of the slave
- Ex 12:2 “This month shall be the beginning of months for you; it is to be the first month of the year to you.
- Ex 12:3 Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, ‘On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers’ households, a **lamb for each household**.

# Joshua Generation 5

- Ex 12:6 .. then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight. 7 Moreover, they shall take some of the **blood** and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses in which they eat it. 8 They shall **eat the flesh** that same night, roasted with fire, and they shall eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.

# Joshua Generation 5

- Ex 11:11 Now you shall eat it in this manner: with your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it in haste—it is the **Lord's** **Passover**. 12 For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike down all the **firstborn** in the land of Egypt,
- John 1:29 The next day he saw **Jesus** coming to him and said, “Behold, the **Lamb of God** who takes away the sin of the world!”

# Joshua Generation 5

- Matt 26:18 .. “My time is near; I am to keep the **Passover** at your house with My disciples.
- Matt 26:26 While they were eating, Jesus took some bread, and after a blessing, He broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, “Take, eat; this is My body.” 27 And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you; 28 **for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.**



# Joshua Generation 5

- Luke 22:15 And He said to them, “I have earnestly desired to eat this **Passover** with you before I suffer<sup>16</sup> for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is **fulfilled in the kingdom of God.**” <sup>17</sup> And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He said, “Take this and share it among yourselves; <sup>18</sup> for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on **until the kingdom of God comes.**”

# Joshua Generation 5

- Luke 22:19 And when He had taken some bread and given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; **do this in remembrance of Me.**” 20 And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, saying, “This cup which is poured out for you is the **new covenant** in My blood.

# Joshua Generation 5

- Luke 22:29 and just as My Father has granted Me a kingdom, I grant you so that **you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom**, and **you will sit on thrones** judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Place of kingdom authority in the new covenant is in the heavenly realms seated on thrones

# Joshua Generation 5

- Eph 2:4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up with Him, and **seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus**, 7 so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.



# Joshua Generation 5

- 1 Cor 10:16 The cup of blessing [of wine at the Lord's Supper] upon which we ask [God's] blessing, does it not mean [that in drinking it] **we participate in and share a fellowship** (a communion) in the **blood** of Christ (the Messiah)? The bread which we break, does it not mean [that in eating it] **we participate in and share a fellowship** (a communion) in the **body** of Christ?

# Joshua Generation 5

- 1 Cor 11:23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” 25 In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, **as often as you drink it**, in remembrance of Me.”

# Joshua Generation 5

- Act 2:42 They were **continually devoting** themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the **breaking of bread** and to prayer.<sup>43</sup> Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles. <sup>44</sup> And all those who had believed were together and had all things in common; <sup>45</sup> and they began selling their property and possessions and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need.



# Joshua Generation 5

- Act 2:46 **Day by day** continuing with one mind in the temple, and **breaking bread from house to house**, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, 47 praising God and having favour with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.



# Joshua Generation 5

- 1 Cor 11:27 Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. 28 But a man must examine himself.. 29 For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly. 30 For this reason many among you are **weak and sick, and a number sleep.**

# Joshua Generation 5

- John 6:32 Jesus then said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, it is not Moses who has given you the bread out of heaven, but it is My Father who gives you the **true bread out of heaven**. 33 For the **bread of God** is that which comes down out of heaven, and **gives life to the world**.”

# Joshua Generation 5

- John 6:48 I am the bread of life. 49 Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. 50 This is the bread which comes down out of heaven, so that one may eat of it and **not die**. 51 I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, **he will live forever** ...

# Joshua Generation 5

- John 6:53 So Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, **you have no life in yourselves** 55 For My flesh is true food, and My blood is true drink. 56 He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood **abides in Me, and I in him.** 58 This is the bread which came down out of heaven; not as the fathers ate and died; he who eats this bread will live forever.”



# Joshua Generation 5

- John 6:63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life.
- Applying the body & blood of Christ has the power to remove the blockages of our eternal inheritance

# Joshua Generation 5

- To receive our full inheritance we have to deal with the giants and kings of our blood-lines occupy the promise land in our lives
- “Ites” & kings represent enemy activity, familiar & familial spirits, sinful & iniquitous behaviour & genetic patterns in our lives

# Joshua Generation 5

- First born – self, old man identity in control has to die
- Old identity of slave & orphan with all the negative genetic records inherited from our parents and their parents etc. has to be transformed
- Inheritance blocked by blood-line iniquity
- Patterns of repetitive sin - rob
- Negative influences – block
- Hidden in our blood-lines but affecting us now

# Joshua Generation 5

- 1 Cor 5:6 Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough? 7 Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For **Christ our Passover** also has been sacrificed. 8 Therefore **let us celebrate the feast**, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.



# Joshua Generation 5

- I engage in the DNA of God I embrace the transforming power of the body & blood of Jesus
- I engage the record containing the light, sound and frequency of God's image
- I embrace the record of the dimensions of the kingdom released in my body by the DNA of God

# Joshua Generation 5

- I engage that DNA record and apply it to my bones.
- I speak to my marrow and command it to live
- I apply the frequency of God's DNA to transform me into the image of Jesus
- Transform every genetic record, re-sequence my DNA into alignment

# Joshua Generation 5

- I apply the blood of Jesus to transform all impure genetic material - be transformed
- I apply the blood of Jesus to all iniquitous genetic patterns - be cleansed
- I call all my genetic material to resonate with the DNA of God and come in alignment with my eternal image

# Joshua Generation 5

- I choose to bear the image of my Father in heaven
- I choose to bear the image of my Brother in heaven
- Let the breath of God be breathed into my life transforming me into a living being joined to the Lord and one spirit with Him



# Joshua Generation 5

- I speak creative words to my DNA to release the supernatural abilities of God
- I trigger the ability to see in the realm of the kingdom
- I trigger the ability to move in the realm of the kingdom.
- I trigger the creative ability to transform matter
