What is Prophecy?

- The gift of Prophecy
 - Encourages the church
 - Brings out the best in people

- Prophetic foretelling knows the future One of them, named Agabus, stood up and through the Spirit predicted that a severe famine would spread over the entire Roman world. (This happened during the reign of Claudius.) Acts 11:28
- Prophetic forth telling causes the future So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them; they came to life and stood up on their feet—a vast army. Ezek 37:10

- Prophecy can change people's hearts
- Prophecy reveals secrets in an unbeliever's heart
- Prophetic gifting causes us to be anointed to perceive what is already happening in the spirit world

Judging and discerning

- Not every voice that speaks to us from the spirit is from God
- Four sources
 - Our spirit
 - The Holy Spirit
 - Evil spirits
 - Angels

Do not quench the Spirit; do not despise prophetic utterances (gifts). But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; 1 Thess 5:19-21

- The word must be congruent (like-minded, consistent, harmonious) with scripture and the heart of God
- It must bear witness with the spirit of the person who hears it
- Person receiving it is brought closer to God and His people

Growing in the gift

Matt 25:14-28 (parable of the talents)

- Use what you have and more will be given to you
- Don't diminish what you have
- Don't compare yourself to others
- Be obedient
- Step out in faith, beyond your comfort zone
- Practice

Why prophesy?

- It brings life Ezek 37:1-4
- We can speak life to ourselves, others and to circumstances
- It gives spiritual vision
- It guides and directs you (wisdom)
- It can reveal God's plans for you
- It can enable you to move forward, to grow and develop

- It strengthens, encourages and comforts But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort 1 Cor 14:3
- It can bring out your destiny, calling and gifting
- It can reveal hidden pain, hurts, wounds, blockages and strongholds...and God's plan for restoration!

- It expresses God's goodness and His desire to bless us
- It can give us insight into what God is doing
- It can give us strategies to exercise our authority
- It can reveal God's love for you
- Ushers in God's Glory
- Prophetic words cause God to act

- Speak from a place of peace
- Be accountable
